DID YOU KNOW?

Private wells should be tested every three years for heavy metals

What's tested?

Water and urine samples will be tested for arsenic, mercury, uranium, cadmium, manganese, and selenium. Creatinine (naturally produced in urine) will also be measured. We will not test for any other chemicals.

Who is eligible?

People who drink from a private well and are at least 6 years old.

How do I benefit?

Exposure to high levels of heavy metals may affect health. Knowing levels of metals in your well may help you take steps to protect your health.
