



Free Water Testing

Test **YOUR** Drinking Water for Arsenic and Other Metals

- Do you have a private or shared well?
- Do you live in **Community Name**?
- Are you interested in knowing about your water quality?
- Would you like free water testing?

If you answered yes to all of these questions above, you may want to consider participating in a new study by the New Mexico Department of Health to understand exposure to metals and other chemicals in the community.

The free test will check for toxic chemicals such as metals in your drinking water and metals and phthalates (chemicals in plastics) in your body (through a small sample of your urine).

In addition to receiving free water testing, you will also receive free advice on how to reduce your exposure to metals and other chemicals, such as phthalates.

Water and urine samples will be collected on:

Fridays and Saturdays:

Aug. 21st & 22nd, Aug. 28th & 29th, and Sept. 25th & 26th

There are a limited number of tests available.
